#### Rules:

- The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration.
- Five races are scheduled. One race constitutes a regatta. All races will be scored.
- A sixth, separate race may be held to determine the Waccamaw Cup.
- Racing is open to all classes.
- Three or more boats of the same class will be scored One-Design. Others will be scored Open Portsmouth.
- Races will be scored using the Low Point System as defined by Appendix A, Racing Rules of Sailing.
- Awards will be given based on registered boats. 1<sup>st</sup> place for a three boat class, 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> for a five boat class, 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> for a nine boat class, 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> for a fifteen boat class, and 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> for a class of twenty or more boats.
